Mr. Jose Becerra (DOB: 03/25/2004). He sought treatment for a mental health-related disorder that can be found in the DSM-V. I'm familiar with his emotional-mental history and with the functional limitations imposed by this mental health-related disorder.

Due to this emotional disorder, Mr. Becerra has certain limitations coping with what would otherwise be considered normal, significant day to day situations, such as symptoms of anxiety (including, lack of interest in daily activities, worrying cognitions, feelings of frustration and an inability to self soothe).

To help alleviate these challenges and to enhance his day-to-day functionality, I have prescribed Mr. Becerra to obtain two cats as his emotional support animals, specifically a Long Hair Domestic cat named Salem that weighs 10 lbs, and a Short Hair Domestic cat named Quinn that weighs 9 lbs. These animals are necessary for the mental health of Mr. Becerra because their presence will mitigate the symptoms he is currently experiencing.

- Salem (Cat – Long Hair Domestic, 10 lbs):  
Helps Mr. Becerra feel calmer when his thoughts keep bothering his and when he feels overwhelmed, primarily through petting.
- Quinn (Cat – Short Hair Domestic, 9 lbs):  
Helps Mr. Becerra feel less frustrated and more at ease during the day, primarily through petting

I am licensed to practice therapy and to prescribe ESAs for treatment. My license number is MFT- 46136 and it was issued in 2008. This letter should suffice as proof of treatment and certification of obtaining and keeping these emotional support animals in his dwelling, in accordance with the Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act.
