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To Whom It May Concern:

Ms. Lauren McKinnis (DOB: 10/11/1992). She sought treatment for a mental health-related disorder that can be found in the DSM-V. I'm familiar with her emotional-mental history and with the functional limitations imposed by this mental health-related disorder.

Due to this emotional disorder, Ms. McKinnis has certain limitations coping with what would otherwise be considered normal, significant day-to-day situations, such as symptoms of anxiety (including, lack of interest in daily activities, worrying cognitions, feelings of frustration and an inability to self soothe).

To help alleviate these challenges and to enhance her day-to-day functionality, I have prescribed that Ms. McKinnis obtain an Emotional Support Animals. Her ESAs are Zeus a Mixed Breed dog weighing approximately 5 lbs and Piper a cat approximately 10 lbs. These animals are necessary for the mental health of Ms. McKinnis because their presence will mitigate the symptoms she is currently experiencing.

- Zeus (Mixed Breed Dog – 5 lbs): Helps Ms. McKinnis feel more at ease when her thoughts keep running and bothering her, primarily through petting.
- Piper (Cat – 10 lbs): Helps Ms. McKinnis feel less frustrated and more settled during the day, primarily through petting.

I am licensed to practice therapy and to prescribe ESA for treatment. My license number is MFT- 46136 and it was issued in 2008. This letter should suffice as proof of treatment and certification of obtaining and keeping these emotional support animals.

I prescribe that Ms. McKinnis keep her Emotional Support Animals in her dwelling, in accordance with the Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act.
