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To Whom It May Concern:

Mr. Nelson Carey Harris (DOB: 10/15/1993). He sought treatment for a mental health-related disorder that can be found in the DSM-V. I'm familiar with his emotional-mental history and with the functional limitations imposed by this mental health-related disorder.

Due to this emotional disorder, Mr. Harris has certain limitations coping with what would otherwise be considered normal, significant day-to-day situations, such as symptoms of anxiety (including persistent worry, emotional tension, difficulty maintaining calm and an inability to self soothe).

To help alleviate these challenges and to enhance his day-to-day functionality, I have prescribed Mr. Harris to obtain Emotional Support Animals. Her ESA pets are two cats. Jax and Pepe Le Mew, two Domestic Longhair Cats weighing 15 lbs and 8 lbs respectively. These animals are necessary for the mental health of Nelson Carey Harris, as each pet provides essential emotional support that directly addresses different symptoms related to her condition.

- Jax (Cat – Domestic Longhair, 15 lbs): Helps promote emotional steadiness by providing consistent companionship and reassurance. Additionally, Jax supports relaxation and stress relief, primarily through petting.
- Pepe Le Mew (Cat – Domestic Longhair, 8 lbs): Helps reduce emotional tension by offering calming interaction and a grounding presence. Additionally, Pepe supports emotional balance and calmness, primarily through petting.

I am licensed to practice therapy and to prescribe ESA for treatment. My license number is MFT- 46136 and it was issued in 2008. This letter should suffice as proof of treatment and certification of obtaining and keeping these emotional support animals. I recommend that Mr. Harris keep his Emotional Support Animals in his dwelling, in accordance with the Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act.
